

## MAJOR ARBITRATION EXPERIENCE | OIL & GAS

- Acted as Respondent's delay, quantum and technical experts in an international arbitration seated in India for an EPC project related to the expansion of a gas processing facility. The arbitration was between an Australian contractor and an Indian E&P company. The value of the claims was USD 67 million.
- Acted as Claimant's delay, quantum and technical experts for an EPC offsite and utility project for a USD 6 billion greenfield petrochemical project, one of the largest projects in Asia. The total claim value was USD 200 million, and the arbitration was seated in India. The disputes involved complex design issues related to pipe racks, pilling works, geotechnical matters, flare design, etc. The arbitration (ad-hoc) was between a Turkish EPC contractor and India's biggest national oil company.
- Acted as Claimant's delay, quantum and technical experts for international arbitration for USD 60 million cross country pipeline and jetty terminal project in India. The project was an EPC project and disputes involved availability of right of way and statutory clearances resulting into a delay in the works.
- Acted as Respondent's delay and quantum experts for SIAC based arbitration related to Liquid Metering Systems for a grass root refinery project in Eastern India. The arbitration was between a Turkish EPC contractor and a US based metering system manufacturer.
- Acted as delay and quantum experts for SIAC arbitration between a major EPC company and Fortune 500 E&P company for a gas processing plant EPC project in Singapore. The dispute involved insolvency related issues and disruptions due to the same.
- Acted as Claimant's technical expert for a shipping company and bunker fuel supplier related to the quality of the fuel supplied and its deviations from the specification.
- Acted as delay expert for an underground cavern storage EPC project in Southern India. The dispute is on account of the delay in water flooding of the cavern.
- Acted as Delay/Technical/Quantum expert for dispute between two partners of a joint venture for an offshore project in Mumbai under SIAC arbitration.
- Respondent's delay, technical and quantum expert in ICC arbitration for a USD 0.5 billion onshore oil & gas project in Libya between Italian main EPC contractor and National Oil Company. The dispute arose due to force majeure issues and other delays in the project resulting in a claim for prolongation cost and other damages including variations.
- Claimant's delay and quantum expert for UAE based tank fabrication EPC company for its ICC arbitration under Kuwaiti law for a USD 1.5 billion oil & gas project wherein, the respondent is a JV of major oil & gas EPC companies. The dispute mainly comprises of damages due to multiple rounds of de-scoping of the work and associated disruption.
- Claimant's quantum expert for Respondent which is a national oil company of the Middle East in its ICC arbitration against the UK headquartered PMC consultant for professional negligence dispute. Instructed by a major law firm from the USA, which is amongst the top 5 international arbitration law firms.
- Acted as Respondent's technical expert for assessing the salvage value of a chimney stack package between a major power EPC contractor and a German manufacturer.





- Acted as Respondent's delay and quantum experts for an air handling Build Own and Operate (BOO) project for a Fortune 500 French company and steel manufacturer. This is an ad-hoc arbitration seated in London. The dispute involved quantum assessment for the valuation of the plant and damage assessment due to the termination of the BOO Contract.
- Acted as Claimant's delay and quantum expert for an EPC project for the LNG terminal project based on Indian laws. The project is based in Western India.
- Acted as Respondent's Independent Delay Analysis and Quantum Analysis Expert in an ICC arbitration related to the Oil & Gas Processing facilities project in Libya. Instructed by one of the biggest international law firm.
