

MAJOR ARBITRATION EXPERIENCE | RAILWAYS (INCLUDING METRO) & AIRPORTS

Railways

- Acted as Respondent's delay, quantum and technical experts in an ad-hoc arbitration for a tunneling work for a metro project in India. The dispute was related to unforeseeable site conditions encountered by the Contractor resulting in delays and disruptions. The total value of the claim was USD 250 million.
- Acted as Respondent's delay and quantum experts for a metro rail project in India in an ad-hoc arbitration. The project involved tunneling and civil, MEP works for the underground stations and 47kms of underground tunneling works.
- Quantum Expert for India's biggest Railway Project (USD 10 Billion) for ICC based arbitration between a major Government Employer and a consortium led by one of the biggest contracting organisations in India.
- Claimant's Delay and Quantum expert for first Monorail project in India and the third largest monorail system in the world with a cost of approximately USD 411.1 Million. The dispute arose due to the delays occurred in the project and the project was not completed within the stipulated or forecasted timelines. The Claimant suffered massive extra cost and liabilities due to prolonged stay at site and delays which were not attributable to it. The arbitration was on unlawful termination.
- Acted as delay expert for a USD 1 billion dispute on the BOT metro rail project in Mumbai for ad-hoc arbitration. The dispute is due to a delay in providing land for station construction.

Airports

- Acted as Claimant's delay and quantum experts on a USD 500 million, airport expansion project in Muscat, Oman between Oman's biggest construction company and Omani government entity.
- Delay and Quantum Expert's for a reputed stone supply organisations of Sultanate of Oman for dispute pertaining to one of the largest airports of Sultanate of Oman.
